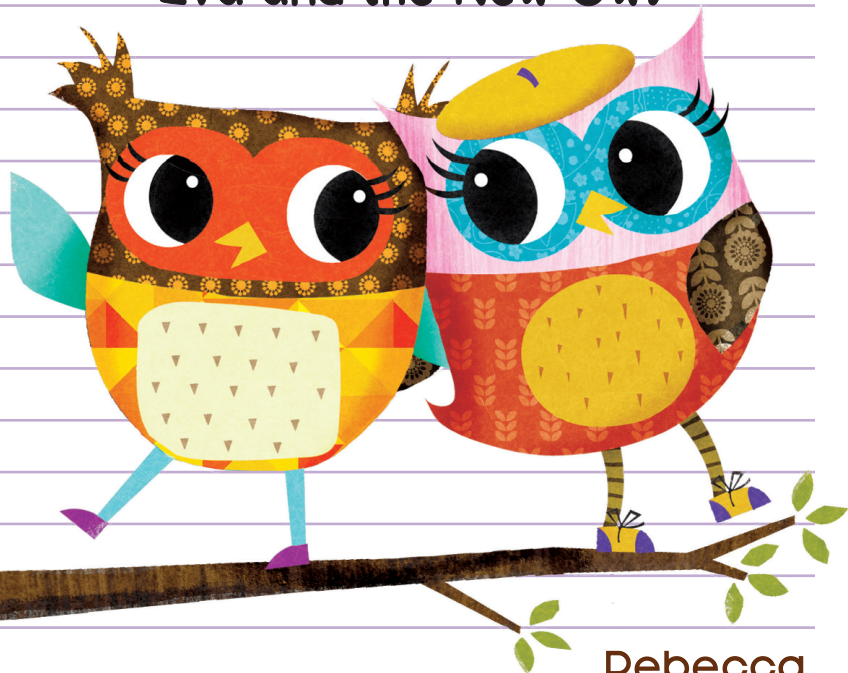

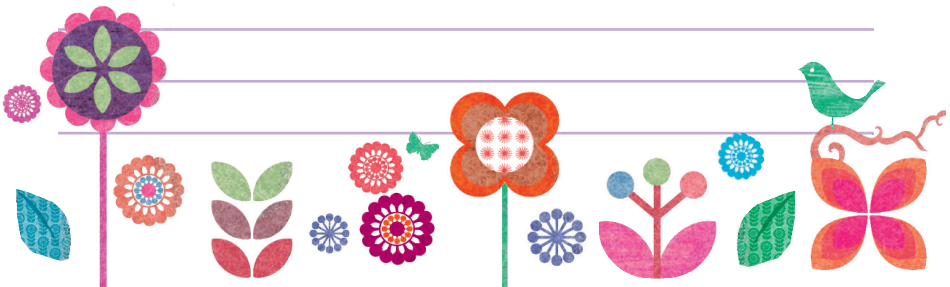

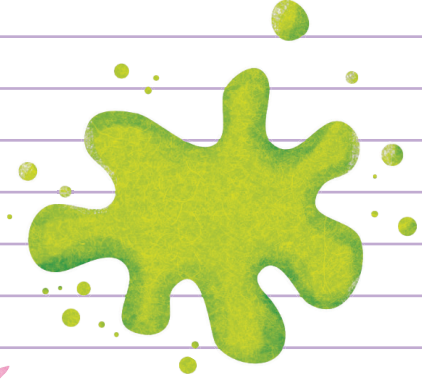

Treetopolis.



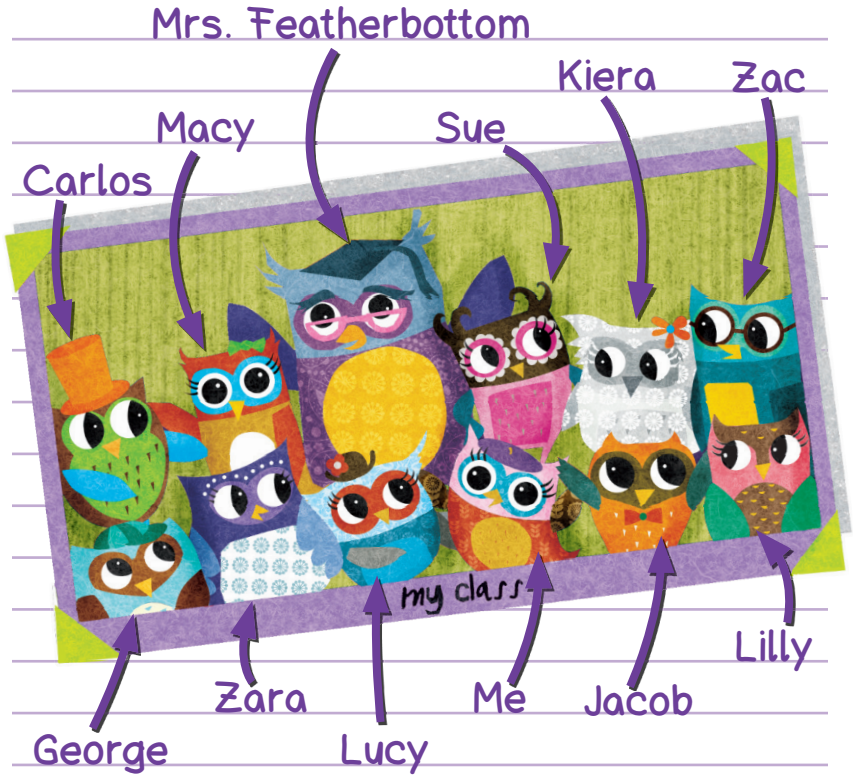
My next-door
