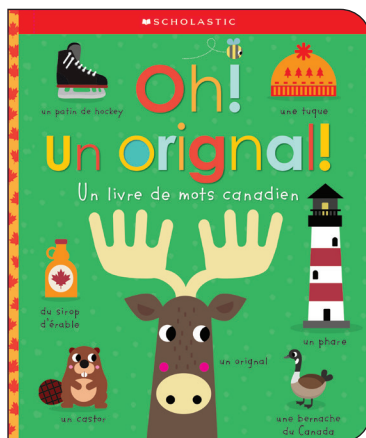

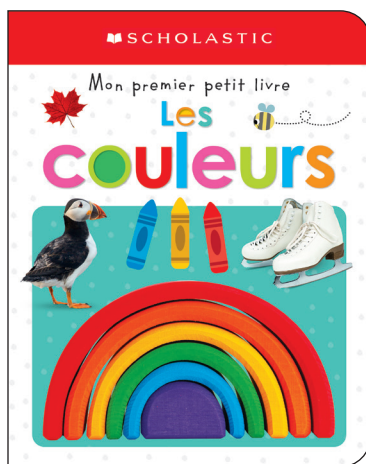

SHAWN HARRIS's first illustrated book, *Her Right Foot* by Dave Eggers, received seven starred reviews, was an Orbis Pictus Award Honor Book, an ALA Notable, and a PW Best Book of the Year. His other picture books include *Eggers's What Can a Citizen Do*, which was a *Time Magazine* Best Children's Book, and *Everyone's Awake* by Colin Meloy. Kwame writes for children of all ages. His other works include *Surf's Up*, a picture book; *Booked*, a middle grade novel; and *He Said She Said*.

KADIR NELSON illustrated two Caldecott Honor Books: *Moses* and *Libre : Le long voyage d'Henri*. *Ellington Was Not a Street* by Ntozake Shange won the Coretta Scott King Award. Will Smith's *Just The Two of Us* won an NAACP Image Award, and his new book, *We Are The Ship* continues to garner major awards.
