## Discussion/Review Questions

If you were trying to send a similar message to your closest relative or best friend, what would you draw? Draw a picture of this animal, or symbol, and explain why it's meaningful.
4. Winter mentions that families in medieval times often had a coat of arms. Using resources at the library or online, find examples of a coat of arms and then design one for your family name. Don't forget to include a motto!
5. Cal wakes up unharmed and untied in Dingo Bone Valley after Kelvin was supposed to shoot him. He notices that he has letters and numbers on his left ankle. What do you think they mean, and how do you think they got there?
6. Cal notes that the old prospectors, Snake and Jacko, are behaving strangely. At first he thinks they're crazy, but then he overhears Snake saying they plan to turn him in for the reward. Should Cal have been suspicious of their intentions earlier? What are some clues that might have alerted Cal they might not be on his side?
