

MOTOR-MOUSE Crossword Puzzle

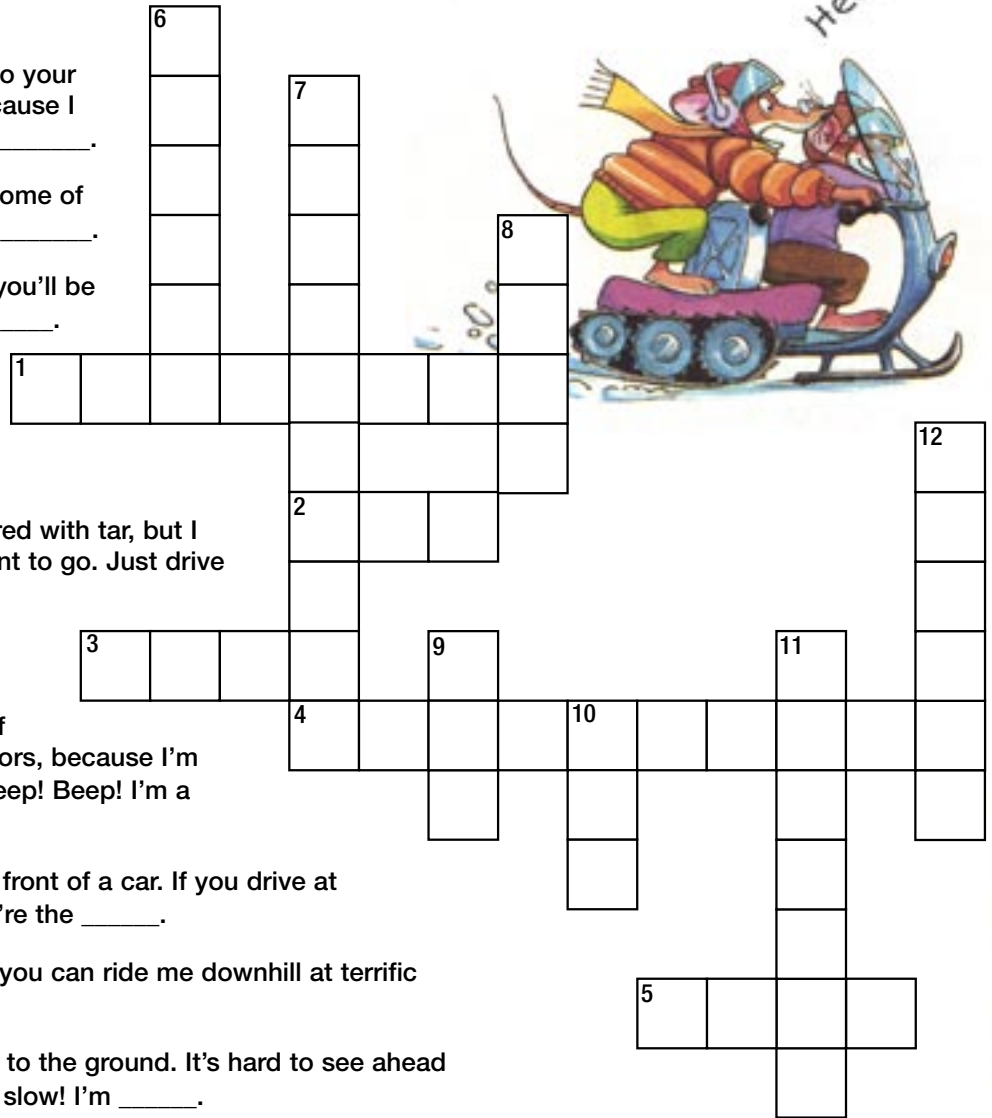
